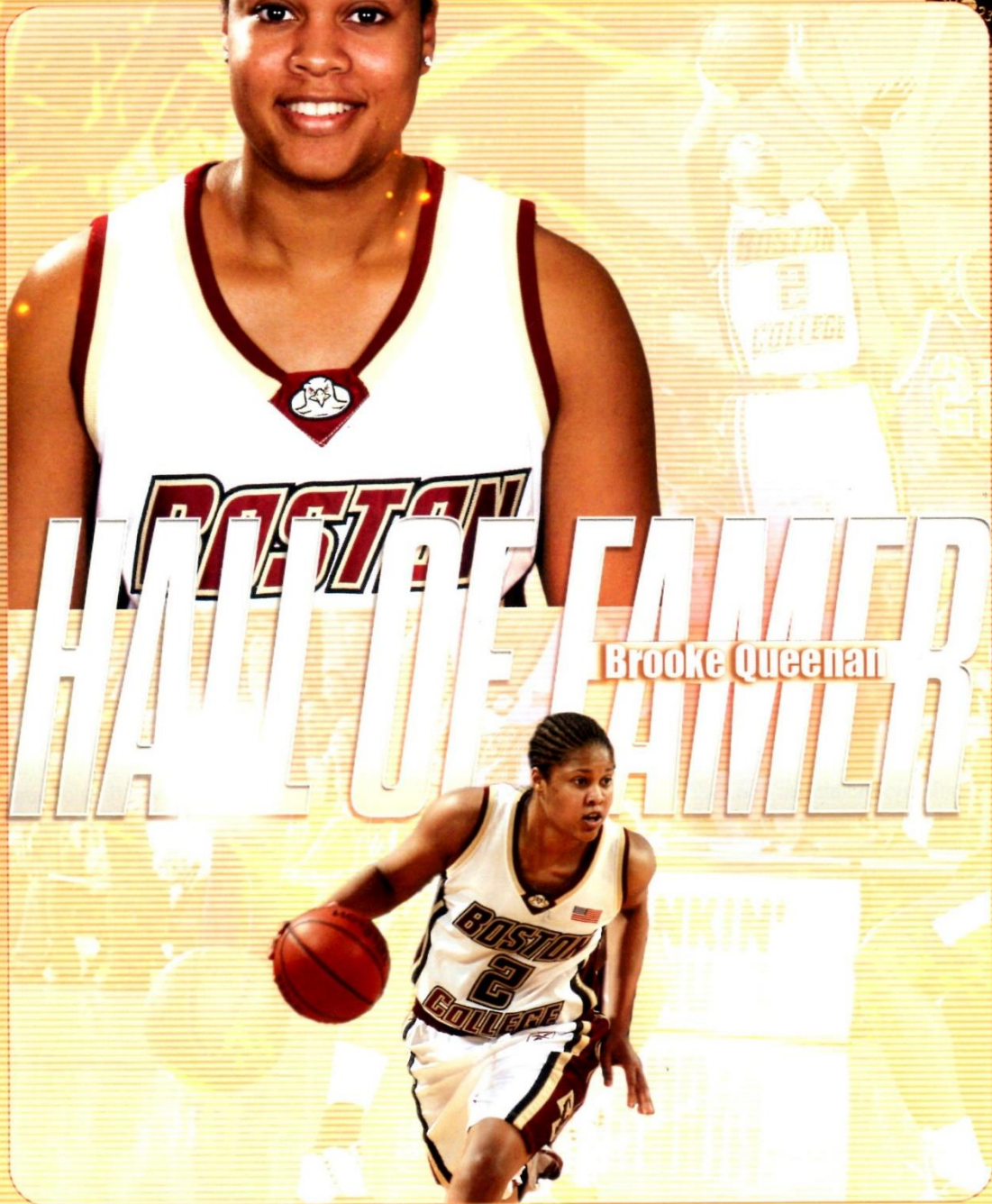

As she grew up in West Chester, Pennsylvania, Brooke idealized her brother, wanting to do everything he did. The pair both fell in love with basketball at a young age, and Brooke credits it to her mother's and grandfather's influence. She says that, "Basketball will always remind me of my brother, mom, and grandfather first and continues to bring a lot of joy to our family."

Brooke chose BC with its ideal balance between highly competitive sports and academic rigor. Especially with the beautiful campus, location near the city, and proximity to home, BC was an easy choice. During the time Brooke attended BC, her mother also played basketball at Sacred Heart University, extending the importance basketball had throughout their family.

While she loved her academic experience at BC, much of Brooke's time spent at BC was in athletics. She will always remember the moments with her teammates the most, cherishing how they succeeded, failed, and grew up alongside each other. Brooke feels deeply grateful for all the opportunities basketball gave her, and is most appreciative of all the people at BC who became family along the way. Even today, these relationships have continued to expand and deepen after college.

Throughout her collegiate basketball career, Brooke led the Eagles to yearly NCAA Tournament appearances (2002-2006). In the same year she was tri-captain at BC, she was selected 23rd in the 2006 WNBA Draft by the New York Liberty.

Women's Basketball

A reliable post-player that successfully helped captain BC from the BIG EAST to the ACC, while reaching a fourth-straight NCAA Tournament.

- Scored 987 points and pulled down 560 rebounds in 111 games at BC
- Helped lead her teams to four NCAA Tournaments, including three Sweet 16 appearances
- Averaged career-best 15.1 points and 8.1 rebounds per game as a senior, while shooting .499 from the field and .808 at the free throw line
- Earned All-ACC Second Team in 2006
- Set the single-season rebound record in 2006 with 266
- Selected in the second-round pick of the 2006 WNBA Draft by the New York Liberty and played nine years of professional basketball



After finishing her playing career, Brooke moved to Phoenixville, Pennsylvania and attended graduate school at Northeastern. She is very close with her family who all live close by, including her mom, dad, and brother's family—Brooke is a very proud aunt to Julian, Briea, and Cameron. She also continues to have several close friendships with her BC teammates that span many years, countries, and continents, including former Eagles Aja Parham and Christine Smith. Today, Brooke is an active and engaged member of the Philadelphia Youth Basketball (PYB) Board of Directors. PYB is a community-built youth empowerment organization that leverages the iconic game of basketball to help today's urban youth overcome the most urgent and systemic issues facing underserved communities. Brooke currently acts as the Vice Chairperson and will transition to Chairperson next year.
